Stainglass Window North Wall Nave.

1. To the glory of god in loving memory of / Mary Stone born Nov 1st 1844 died Sept 28th 1925 / + Ray Stone born Oct 17th 1836 died Aug 5th 1905 this / window is erected by their daughter Romaine Monson.

North Wall Nave.

2. Erected / by the parishioners / of / Burton - by - Lincoln / in grateful mmeory of the men / of this parish / who fell in the great war /. 1914 - 1918 / Frank Baldock / George Henry Daubney / Albert Clarence Denton / Charles Ernest Leedell / Cyril George Ormsky /. Their name liveth for evermore.

Brass Plague Window Sill North Wall Nave.

3. This window is dedicated / by friends and Kinsfolk to the glory of God and in pious memory of / Arthur Roland Maddison M.A. F.S.A. / born 1843 - died 1912 / educated at Rugby school and Merton College Oxford / who served this church of St Vincent as curate and after - wards as rector / for nearly twenty years and was for thirty - seven years priest vicar and / subsequently Prebendary of the Cathedral Church of Lincoln / his consant care for their spiritual and bodily welfare won / him the affection and respect of the inhabitants of this parish / while beyond its boundarieshe was widely known and appreciated / as the author of Archaeological and Genealogical Researchers which / have done much to illuminate the history of his native County / A.S. 1913 / MULTIS ILLE BONIS FLREBILS OCCIDIT.

4. To the precious memory of hir dearest husband / neare unto rest the body's of Christopher Randes Esqs + Katheren his / wife daughter of Tho. Moulderford of Lon. Dr. in Phy. By whom he had / issue 5 sonnes, Tho ; Moulderford; Hen: Iohn + 3 daughters Mary / Briget + Elizabeth the sad xofer, Kather: Departed Feb 4 A^o DMN. 1639.

South Wall Beside Altar.

5. In memory of / Thomas Lancaster Larken / second son of / the Rev Edmund Roberts Larken M.A. / Rector of this parish / he died at Foo Chow China / Febuary 5th 1870 / aged 34 years /. Mine eyes have seen thy salvation.

South Wall Chancel Above Choir Stalls.

6. In memory of / Edmund Lawarence Monson Larken M.D. / H.M. Indian Army / eldest son of / the Rev'd Edmund Roberts Larken M.A. / he died at Byculla Bombay / Febuary 19th 1861 / aged 26 years /. I shall go to him but he shall / not return to me.
